The articles are subject to preliminary editorial review within 6 months and are published on a free basis within one year.

In our journal original articles of clinical and theoretical orientation are published. Articles can be research, review and in the form of cases from clinical practice.

For timely publication of articles, we ask You to submit articles as follows:

Please send a folder with the following separate files:

- **The text of the article** should be in Word format. The title of the text file should contain the journal abbreviation, the surname of the first author, for example: NAMJ Ivanov. The text should be typed on A4 page, with Times New Roman font, with 11 letter size, with 1,0 line spacing and without text formatting.
- **Original images and photos** should be in * .JPEG, * .TIFF, * .PSD format. The title of the picture file should contain the journal abbreviation, the first author's surname and the drawing numbers, for example: NAMJ Ivanov Fig1
- **Diagrams** should be in Excel or SPSS format. The diagram file is titled with journal abbreviation, first author's surname and diagram numbers, for example: NAMJ Ivanov Diag1

Design of the article

1. **The title of the article** should be in printed in common font, for example: Functional testing as the most accurate tool for risk stratification in patients with micro- and macro vessel coronary artery disease.
2. **Surnames and initials of authors**
Note the responsible author's name with asterisk (*) and the workplaces of all authors with numbers, for example: Laretta LM¹, Margonato AT², Fragasso GD^{1,2*}
3. **Workplaces of authors** should be detailed (departments, laboratories, etc.), full name of the institution (not abbreviations), city, country, for example:

4. **Provide a list of abbreviations and designations in an open form.**
5. **Address for correspondence**
Mention the name, surname, scientific degree (in common abbreviations, PhD, etc.), postal address with index, telephone number and e-mail of the responsible author, for example:

6. Abstract

The text should contain 250-300 words; do not use abbreviations and source references in the abstract.

7. Keywords

8. Introduction should be composed of not less than one page.

Literature references in the text should be in square brackets in italic font, if in the source appear

- One author – note the author and year of publication [*Ivanov V, 2005*]
- Two authors – note both authors [*Ivanov V, Petrov S., 2018*]
- Three and more authors – note only the first author [*Ivanov V et al., 2018*]

Used reagents, kits and medication of the study (mention the model, company name and country of their producers)

Literary sources may include journals, books, newsletters, legislation, research articles, and graduate theses, online journals/journals, and electronic resources. All sources should be provided in English.

Articles that were published in English should be submitted as following:

- In all sources, only authors should be presented in Italic format, Write the initials of the authors after the surname, After the last author (or et al.) in brackets indicate the year of publication of this article. If the number of authors exceeds 6, the sixth author should be followed by et al.. The author's names should be italicized. Puccio DH, Novo GD, Baiamonte VK., Vernuccio LE, Novo SK. et al. (2022).
- Write the title of the article.
- Write the name of the journal.
- After the journal name, enter the year of publication, the issue of the journal. specify the numbers of the first and last pages of the article, . If the journal (article) it has a DOI, you must specify it.

Present non-English sources n the references as follows:

In all sources present only the authors in italic font.

Authors (Italic), [translation of the title of article into English] [Published in Armenian], journal title, volume 12 (20018), number 14 and pages.

For example; *Byvaltsev VA, Belykh EG, Sorokovikov VA, Arsentyeva NI. (2011).*[The use of scales and questionnaires in vertebrology] [Published in Russian]. Zhurnal nevrologii i psikiatrii imeni. 2011; 12(4): 51-56.
