

TITLE PAGE DESIGN. INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS.

Use *Times New Roman font*, font size: 11 and 1.5 - *line spacing* both on the title page and throughout the whole article.

Form the paragraph with the following parameters: *In paragraph Spacing* select value: *Before* – 0; *After* – 0. *In paragraph indentation* select value: *Left* – 0; *Right* – 0; *Special* – first line; *By* – 0.5 cm.

Before the title, present information about the authors. For each author, provide the full name, then the last name. Underline the last name. Specify the author's affiliation as it appears under the title. Include the author's ORCID.
