1. Bowel fistulas (stomas)
2. Injuries (traumatic amputation of limb, open fracture of limb)
3. Intestinal obstruction
4. Complications of peptic ulcer disease (perforation, bleeding)
5. Acute calculous cholecystitis
6. Pneumothorax
7. Hydrothorax
8. Wounds
9. Abscesses

### **Interpretation of the X-ray images included in cases**

1. Intestinal obstruction
2. Perforation of hollow organ (free gas)
3. Lung echinacoccosis
4. Lung cancer
5. Pneumothorax
6. Hydrothorax

### **List of the practical skills**

1. Installation of colostomy bag
2. Wound bandage
3. Esmarch tourniquet installation
4. Transport immobilization of the limb
5. Recognition of laparotomy incisions
6. Wound sewing
7. Opening and drainage of the abscess
8. Urine catheter installation

9. Intravenous injection
10. Pleural puncture
11. Placement of a nasogastric tube
12. Implementation of tracheostomy
13. Abdominal palpation during acute surgical pathologies (acute cholecystitis, peritonitis).
