

THE RULES OF ENTRANCE EXAMS FOR FOREIGN APPLICANTS

1. After submitting an application to the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports of the Republic of Armenia, the applicant must fill out the “**APPLICANT’S QUESTIONNAIRE**” on the relevant electronic platform of website of the University: www.ysmu.am
2. An applicant can get acquainted with the schedule of exams on the relevant information platform of the official website of the University (*Admission for Foreign Citizens*).
3. The following general requirements for examinations and appeals are established:
 - The duration of the exam is 60 minutes;
 - The number of tasks consists of 50 tests;
 - Passing score is the correct answers to 26 tests;
 - The results of exam are announced at the University not less than 3 hours after the end of the exam;
 - The applicant has the right to file an appeal within 1 hour after the announcement of the exam results.
4. In the case of 20 to 25 correct answers based on the results of the exam (excluding English language), the applicant is given the opportunity to participate in an additional test of knowledge, for which the following requirements are established:
 - It is held on the day of the exam within 2 hours after the announcement of the results;
 - Duration - 15 minutes, number of tests - 10, passing - 5 correct answers;
 - Results are announced 30 minutes after completion;
 - There is no appeal.

Obligations and rights of the applicant

1. On the day of the exam, the applicant must arrive at the University 30 minutes before the start of the exam.
2. The applicant must have a Passport with him/her.
3. During the exam, the applicant has the right to:
 - use the back side of the examination form as a draft,
 - ask for an extra sheet for a draft, if necessary,
 - ask only technical questions,
 - use a pencil to mark preliminary answers to avoid corrections by pen,
 - use a calculator to solve problems,
 - use the Periodic Table for the chemistry exam.
4. During the exam it is not allowed to:
 - make corrections with a pen in the answers on the examination form,
 - use a mobile phone or other technical device,
 - give a clue and disrupt the course of the exam.
5. The examination form must be completed:
 - with blue pen (answers written in pencil are considered invalid),
 - with no corrections by pen (corrected answer is considered invalid),
 - in full (a form with missing answers will not be accepted).
