

## Curriculum vitae (CV) of Prof. Dr. med. habil. Ulrich Stephani

Ulrich Stephani, born 1954, studied human medicine at the Universities of Hanover, Würzburg and Berlin. He received his license to practice medicine in 1977 (West-Berlin), was certified as a pediatrician in 1989 followed by “Habilitation” and “Venia legendi” (allowance to give lectures) in 1990 (Göttingen).

From 1992 to 2018 he held the function as Director of the Dept. of Neuropaediatrics at Kiel University, as well as Director of the Northern German Epilepsy center for children and adolescents. Between 1998 and 2007 Ulrich Stephani was the first secretary of the German chapter of the International League against epilepsy (ILAE: Deutsche Gesellschaft für Epileptologie), in 1999 and 2000 he was president of the German speaking Society for Neuropediatrics. In 2013 he was appointed to Dean of the Medical Faculty at Kiel university until 2020, from 2018 on he was board member of University clinics of Schleswig Holstein (UKSH).

He and his team completed several third party funded research projects on epilepsy genetics, network detection in the developing brain and therapeutic studies. With him as author and coauthor there were published more than 250 articles on Neuropaediatrics and pediatric epileptology.

After his retirement in 2020 he is active in several functions at Kiel University (e.g. critical friend in collaborate research projects, coorganizer in educational projects), consultant at the “Northern German Epilepsy center for children and adolescents” and since 2022 chair of Michael foundation.
